**Place: Haliburton County Public Library Minden Hills Branch**

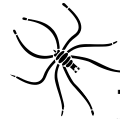
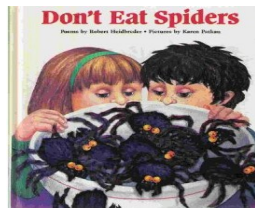
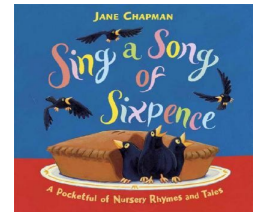

The children will make a simple rhythm instrument to use as we chant, sing and move to some of our favourite nursery rhymes!



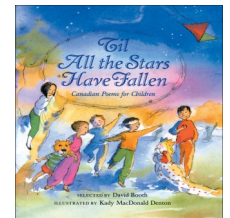
## July 10 - Don't Eat Spiders!
