- This exhibition is open to all artists living in Canada.
- One piece of work allowed per artist.
- Art work may be in any media.
- Digital image must be in jpeg format.
- All work must be created by the entrant.
- Work must not have been shown in any other public venue.

### For work selected for exhibition:

- All work must be ready for exhibiting.
- Two dimensional works (or three dimensional works that are to be wall mounted) should be ready to hang, mounted or framed, and with hanging wire.
- The gallery reserves the right to disqualify any work that misrepresents what was on the CD used in the jurying process.
- The jury's decision is final. No entry may be withdrawn once it has been accepted.
- All shipping arrangements and associated costs, to and from the gallery, are the responsibility of the exhibiting artist.
- The gallery will insure the work to market value while the work is on the premise.
- The artist grants the Agnes Jamieson Gallery the right to photograph accepted works for publicity, educational and catalogue purposes only.
- The gallery exhibiting the work will retain a 25% commission on all sales.  
Works are not required to be for sale.
